About the Film

Trusted Moments is designed to be used within schools and youth services as a tool for facilitating discussion and learning about the law of consent and the importance of respectful relationships.

It was developed by the Legal Services Commission as an early intervention strategy for the prevention of sexual assault.

Set at a 17th birthday party, the film draws attention to attitudes and behaviours that can lead to sexual assault. It also highlights the inherent legal risks associated with using mobile phones for producing and sharing sexually explicit images of young people.

How your school or organisation might use *Trusted Moments*

Achieving attitudinal change around the issues of relationship and sexual violence requires time and ongoing commitment. It is critical that early intervention programs are provided through frameworks that can support their sustained implementation.

A *Trusted Moments* Study Guide has been developed to support learning about the issues raised in the film. The Study Guide contains suggested group activities to generate discussion about the importance of respect and consent, with the aim of helping young people recognise and prevent the types of behaviours and attitudes which may lead to sexual violence.

It also contains legal fact sheets on the topics of:

- Consent
- Sexual Assault
- Mobile Phones and Online Safety

The Study Guide also outlines ways in which schools and youth services may gain the most benefit from *Trusted Moments* as an early intervention tool, provides strategies for the emotional safety of young people and staff using the resource, and outlines key learning objectives.
