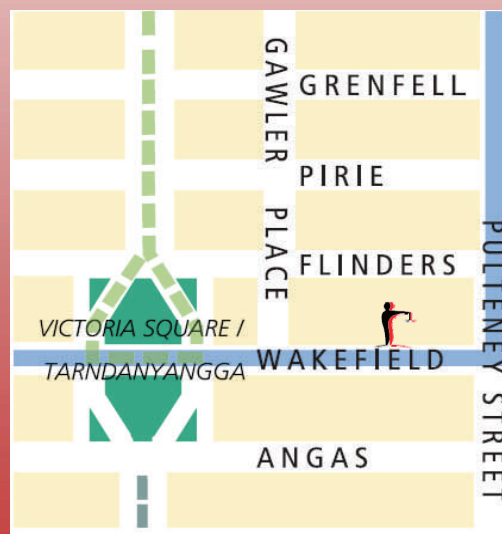
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Educating Your Community

Does **your** community want to know more about **Australian Family Law**?

Many people have trouble understanding laws that affect families in Australia.

The Legal Services Commission runs a special project for new and emerging migrant communities who want to know more about Australian law.

We have met with many community leaders and workers from African, Asian and Middle Eastern communities and have learnt much about how family law works in different countries, cultures and religions.

Migrant communities tell us that knowing more about Australian law ensures success for themselves, their families and their communities.



Legal Education Workshops

Communities **can** learn more about many **topics** including:

- Where can I get legal advice?
- What does the law say about disciplining my child?
- When can I get married in Australia?
- There are problems in my marriage where can I get help?
- What happens if we divorce?
- What happens to the children?
- How will the property be divided?
