Litigation Assistance Fund

Assistance for individuals and small businesses to pursue civil matters only, not criminal or family problems. There is a \$100 application fee, and if the case is unsuccessful, the litigant is liable for the other side's costs. 15% of proceeds from the case are returned to the fund.

Disbursements Only Fund

To assist in the payment of disbursements such as court fees, medical reports, interpreter fees, witness fees, etc.
